


- Parallel Glass Panels or Blown Glass Braided Fabric Cord
- C. Cord grip (Attached to canopy)

Assembly Instructions


Step 1: Remove Canopy Faceplate by unscrewing the Flat Knob in the Center of the Canopy and sliding Faceplate off of IP. Feed the braided fabric cord into the Faceplate until the desired amount of cord is left between the canopy and light body. Take into account that a minimum of 6" of cord will be required for connecting the wiring to the driver.

Step 2: Mount the canopy to the ceiling using the provided Mounting Instructions.

Step 3: Using the E-Z Toggle kits (see E-Z Toggle Instructions on the next page) included in the Hardware pack, install Swag Hooks radially around where the Canopy will be mounted using a measuring tape to achieve the desired distance. Holding the faceplate in the approximate location it will be installed, hold the braided cloth cord next to a swag hook to determine the desired sag and pendant length. Once the desired configuration is determined. tighten the cord grip using a flat blade screw driver. The cord grip is on the Faceplate. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN. THIS MAY DAMAGE THE FIXTURE.

Step 4: Make wire connections to the driver using the installed terminal block. Connect any pendant to an available terminal housing.

DO NOT REMOVE ANY PREINSTALLED WIRES



LOOK MAY VARY WHITE wire to WH **BLACK** wire to **BK**

Make wire connections from driver to source power. WHITE to WHITE, BLACK to BLACK, and ground the fixture to the canopy.

WARNING

DO NOT DIRECTLY CONNECT LEDS TO AC POWER.

LEDs will be damaged if exposed to high voltages. The LED's must be wired in series to work properly.

Step 5: Install Faceplate onto Canopy and screw Flat knob onto the IP in the center of the Canopy to secure the

Step 6: Attach glass to LED pendant housing

Prior to installing glass ensure all cords are properly secured through each swag hook so the glass is being supported by the swag hook and not the canopy. Solely supporting by the canopy may overload the J-Box mount resulting in damage.

Gem, Hedra, Rock Crystal, or Aalto Pendant: Use #4-40 flat head screws provided to attach glass to pendant housing.










Hedra Rock Crystal

Ledgestone Pendant: Use #8-32 nylon tip set screws to retain blown glass.

If Axis Pendant:

Slide glass along retention screws using slot in glass. Slide pendant cover over glass and tighten finial until snug.

If Blossom Pendant:

Screw glass element into threaded pendant housing.

If Nebula Pendant: Screw inner glass into socket. Un-Screw Glass Retention nut. Raise the Top Glass Retention Cap up the stem. Slide Glass Shade over inner glass, tilt to the side of the glass allowing the Bottom Glass Retention to slip inside the Glass Shade, slide the rest of the Bottom Glass Retention the rest of the way into the Glass Shade, Allow the Glass to sit on the top of the lips of the Bottom Glass Retention. The opening of the Glass Shade may vary and will not be a perfect circle. Ensure that the Bottom Glass Retention is rotated so that the maximum amount of Glass surface area is resting on the lips. Lower the Top Glass Retention Cap, center the fixture on the Bottom Glass Retention and Secure Retention Nut. (NOTE: Tighten till Snug.

Parallel Glass Pendant: Install glass panels by

unscrewing the cylinder knobs until glass can be slid into housing. Note that the cylinder knobs

do not have to be fully removed from the fixture to install glass panels. Tighten the cylinder knobs, ensuring that the all thread passes through the glass

If Raindrop Glass Pendant: Install blown glass by raising cover to expose the electrical assembly at the end of the braided cord. Place frosted diffuser in glass mount, frosted side down, and screw the glass assembly onto the threaded LED mount. Tighten with wrench. Next, lower cover back over glass and screw to tighten down.

(NOTE: Tighten cover till Snug. DO NOT Overtighten!)







Turn E-Z Toggle into drywall until seated flush. Arrows on head indicate direction toggle clamp will open. End with arrows up and down.



Place fixture over E-Z Toggle. Push screw into E-Z Toggle to engage clamp



Turn screw until it stops. Toggle clamp tightens against drywall as screw is turned.
